ACTIVE PROJECTS

Winterization 2016-2017 Albania: Provide Firewood, Blankets and Wood Stoves for Heating to Vulnerable Families in Albania

Began December 2016

Albania | Shkodra, Elbasan, Korca and Puke

This project aims to 210 families (orphans' families and other vulnerable families) in Albania during the harsh winter by providing free firewood, blankets and wood stoves for heating.

PROPOSED OUTCOMES:

Distribute 1,050 cubic meters of wood, 210 blankets and 20 wood stoves as needed.

THIS PROJECT IS EXPECTED TO HELP 950 PEOPLE.

Winterization 2016-2017 Iraq: Winterization Response to Syrian Refugees and Iraqi IDPs in Iraq

Began December 2016

Iraq | Erbil, Baghdad, Anbar, Kirkuk and Salah Aldin

This project aims to meet basic humanitarian needs of approximately 6,013 vulnerable families in Iraq (displaced Iraqi families and Syrian refugees).

PROPOSED OUTCOMES:

Distribute stoves, heaters, pillows, mattresses, children's boots, children's clothes and hygiene kits.

THIS PROJECT IS EXPECTED TO HELP 36,078 PEOPLE.

Winterization 2016-2017 Jordan: Providing Winterization Items for Refugees and Vulnerable Jordanian Families

Begins January 2016

Jordan | Northern Areas

This project aims to provide winter items to refugees and vulnerable Jordanian families (484 families) as a part of an emergency response to the harsh winter conditions.

PROPOSED OUTCOMES:

Distribute the following winter items according to the needs of each family: Clothing vouchers, blankets, gas heaters, gas cylinders, winter health kits, gas refill vouchers.

THIS PROJECT IS EXPECTED TO HELP 2,420 PEOPLE.

ACTIVE PROJECTS (cont.)

Winterization 2016-2017 Lebanon: Providing Winterization Items for Refugees from Syria In Lebanon

Began December 2016

Lebanon | Bekaa, Mount Lebanon, North Lebanon

This project aims to provide winterization assistance to an estimated 2,200 families (Syrian refugees and vulnerable host community families living in shelters and camps across Lebanon). Priority will be given to those living in substandard shelters; in areas with severe climactic conditions; and the most vulnerable who may have the most difficulty covering their accommodation, utility and heating or fuel costs.

PROPOSED OUTCOMES:

To provide beneficiaries with fuel gallons, gas heaters, stove heaters, blankets, mattresses, plastic sheeting, food parcels and carpets.

THIS PROJECT IS EXPECTED TO HELP 11,000 PEOPLE.

Winterization 2016-2017 Syria and Turkey: Access to Emergency Winter NFIs for Syrian IDPs and Refugees

Began December 2016

Syria | Syria: Idleb, Aleppo, Hama and Lattakia if access remains possible inside Syria; Turkey: Hatay Province

This project aims to provide winter items to approximately 13,980 displaced Syrian families in Syria and Turkey.

PROPOSED OUTCOMES:

Distribute winter items that may include: Blankets, mattresses, plastic sheeting, water cans, LED solar lamps and chargers, and plastic mats. Clothing kits inside Syria may include: shoes, jackets, hats, sweatshirts, gloves, waterproof coats, and socks. Inside Turkey, families may receive: blankets, mattresses, shoes, sweatshirts, gloves and socks.

THIS PROJECT IS EXPECTED TO HELP 84,000 PEOPLE.



COMPLETED PROJECTS

Urgent Assistance to Syrian Refugee Families in Jordan, Phase 1

Location: Maan, Zarqa, Amman, Ramtha/Irbid and Mafraq, Jordan

December 2011 - May 2012

This project provided humanitarian assistance to victims of the Syrian crisis.

ACHIEVEMENTS:

- Distributed winter necessities such as gas for cooking and kerosene for heat to 538 families
- Distributed 1,609 food packages consisting of: rice, sugar, cooking oil, macaroni, powdered milk, dried beans, salt, tomato paste, feta cheese, chicken bouillon cubes, dried lentils
- Distributed 1,609 hygiene kits consisting of sanitary napkins, shampoo, soap, bleach, laundry detergent, dishwashing soap, tissues, toothpaste
- Provided baby milk for 600 children
- Provided diapers for 341 children
- Subsidized rent for families in need of shelter

THIS PROJECT HELPED 2,147 PEOPLE TOTAL; 538 FAMILIES BENEFITED FROM THE WINTER SUPPLIES.

Afghanistan Winterization Project 2012

Location: Kabul and Balkh Regions of Afghanistan

February 2012 - March 2012

This project aimed to reduce vulnerability to malnutrition and death due to cold and lack of necessary food items for poor families that have fled conflict.

ACHIEVEMENTS:

- 1,000 families received support in the form of charcoal and food items (wheat flour, sugar, cooking oil and rice).

THIS PROJECT HELPED 9,420 PEOPLE.

Urgent Assistance to Syrian Refugee Families in Jordan, Phase II

Location: Amman, Al Karak, Maan, Zarqa, Irbid, Ramtha and Mafraq regions of Jordan

August 2012 - December 2012

This project aimed to provide humanitarian assistance to victims of Syrian crisis

ACHIEVEMENTS:

- Winter necessities were distributed to 219 families in Ramtha and 220 families in Mafraq — a total of 439 families receiving a package of one heater, pillow, mattress and blanket
- 600 food packages distributed, each package containing rice, sugar, cooking oil, macaroni, beans, tomato paste, feta cheese and chicken stock
- 600 hygiene kits distributed, each package containing soap, shampoo, bleach, laundry detergent, dish soap, tissues, toothpaste, sanitary napkins and diapers
- Rent assistance given to 600 families
- Medication supplied to Akilah hospital

THIS PROJECT HELPED APPROXIMATELY 5,000 PEOPLE.

Afghanistan Winterization 2012-2013

Location: Kabul, Afghanistan

January 2013 - March 2013

This project provided food and other items to impoverished, displaced families in Kabul who fled due to conflict or insecurity, and would face difficulties in surviving the winter.

ACHIEVEMENTS:

- 2,883 families from 22 camps in Kabul received charcoal for fuel
- 26,416 people including 93 street children received food
- 450 families from 11 camps in Mazar-e-Sharif received food packs

THIS PROJECT HELPED 26,416 PEOPLE.

Afghanistan Winterization Assistance for Food and Fuel 2014

Location: Kabul, Balkh, Nangarhar, Bamyán and Kandahar provinces, Afghanistan

February 2014 - April 2014

ACHIEVEMENTS:

- 2,643 families received charcoal
- 889 displaced families received food packs for 1 month

THIS PROJECT HELPED 21,552 PEOPLE.

Afghanistan Winterization Assistance: Food and Firewood 2014-2015

Location: Kabul, Nangarhar, Takhar, Badakhshan, and Bamyán provinces, Afghanistan

December 2014 - February 2015

This project provided firewood and food to poor Afghan families who were displaced by war, to assist them in surviving the harsh winter.

ACHIEVEMENTS:

- Provided 400 kg firewood each to 2,000 families
- Provided food packages to 747 families; packages included 49 kg flour, 20 kg rice, 8 kg beans, 5 kg sugar, 5 kg cooking oil and 2 kg salt.

THIS PROJECT HELPED 16,482 PEOPLE.

IMRC Kashmir Relief 2014

Location: Srinagar, Indian-administered Kashmir

December 2014 to June 2015

This project provided emergency winter assistance for flood survivors.

ACHIEVEMENTS:

- Distributed blankets and warm clothing to 1,000 people in six districts
- Distributed 2,000 Ramadan food packages to 500 families; packages included rice, oil, chick peas, sugar, tamarind, chili powder, turmeric and ghee
- Distributed 1,000 additional food packages, consisting of rice, grains, flour, sugar, salt, spices, tea, milk powder and soap

THIS PROJECT HELPED 8,322 PEOPLE.

Urgent Winterization Support for Vulnerable Syrians and Host Community in Jordan 2014

Location: Irbid, Mafraq and Baqa'a, Jordan

February 2014 - August 2014

This project assisted Syrian and Jordanian families with emergency winter supplies for 2 months.

ACHIEVEMENTS:

- 559 families received rugs
- 381 families received rugs and blankets
- 275 families received hygiene kits (diapers, shampoo, soap, sanitary napkins, liquid bleach, laundry soap, dish liquid soap, wet wipes, toothpaste, dish washing sponge)
- At least 75% of the families reported that they were in dire need of winterization items. 17% of the families were vulnerable Jordanian families.

THIS PROJECT HELPED 7,140 PEOPLE.

Winterization Campaign for Syrians inside Syria 2014

Location: Suburbs of Idlib and Aleppo, Syria

February 2014 - November 2014

This project alleviated the suffering of displaced Syrian families during the winter.

ACHIEVEMENTS:

Distributed the following items:

- 3,300 mattresses
- 3,050 blankets:
- 2,920 plastic sheets

THIS PROJECT HELPED 27,930 PEOPLE.

Winterization Support for Displaced Syrians in Northern Syria 2014-2015

Location: Northern Syria

December 2014 - June 2015

This project protected Syrians during the harsh winter.

ACHIEVEMENTS:

- Distributed 35,700 coats, 35,348 pairs of shoes and 31,000 warm undergarments (pants)

THIS PROJECT HELPED 78,500 PEOPLE.

Humanitarian Assistance to the Earthquake Affected in Afghanistan

Location: Badakhshan, Takhar, Kunar and Jalalabad, Afghanistan |

October 2015 - November 2015

This project assisted earthquake survivors.

ACHIEVEMENTS:

- Provided 588 families with 2 blankets and 1 plastic mat each
- Provided 588 families with food packages including 49 kg flour, 10 kg rice, 5 kg sugar, 4 kg beans, 5 liters oil, 2 kg salt

THIS PROJECT HELPED 3,951 PEOPLE.

Winterization Assistance for Vulnerable Families in Afghanistan 2015-2016

Location: Kabul, Nangarhar and Bamyán provinces, Afghanistan

December 2015 - February 2016

This project provided heat and food to people displaced due to war and facing difficulties in surviving the winter.

ACHIEVEMENTS:

- 770 families received firewood distribution for two months in camps around Kabul
- 986 families received blankets in Bamyán province
- 750 families received food packages in Nangarhar province

THIS PROJECT HELPED 22,645 PEOPLE.

Winterization to Displaced People in North of Iraq/Erbil

Location: Erbil area, Iraq

December 2015 - February 2016

This project provided displaced people with winter kits to help cope with the harsh northern Iraqi winter.

ACHIEVEMENTS:

- Distributed the following to 1,372 families: 1 stove, 2 blankets, 2 sets of children's clothes, 2 sets of children's boots, 2 pillows and 2 mattresses.

THIS PROJECT HELPED 6,860 PEOPLE.

Urgent Winterization Assistance for Syrian Refugees and Vulnerable Jordanian Families in Jordan

Location: Irbid, Mafraq, Jarash and Amman, Jordan

December 2015 - June 2016

This project provided Syrian refugees and vulnerable Jordanian families with winter items based on demonstrated need.

ACHIEVEMENTS:

- Distributed waterproof sheets, heater blankets, clothing vouchers and health kits with vitamins and supplements

MORE THAN 9,000 PEOPLE BENEFITED FROM THIS PROJECT.

Providing Winterization Items for Refugees From Syria in Lebanon

Location: Bekaa, South, Mount Lebanon and Beirut, Lebanon

December 2015 - June 2016

This project provided winterization items to vulnerable families (Syrian refugees, Palestinian refugees, and impoverished Lebanese families).

ACHIEVEMENTS:

- Distributed gas heaters, fuel stoves, fuel, winter clothes, blankets, plastic sheets, mattresses, pillows and carpets to families living in shelters.

THIS PROJECT HELPED 21,428 PEOPLE.

Helping Families in Gaza Prepare for Winter

Location: Gaza, Palestine

December 2015 - September 2016

This project assisted Gaza residents with with winter supplies.

ACHIEVEMENTS:

- Distributed nylon rolls, tarps and gas hot plates to families in need of materials for emergency repair of their shelters

THIS PROJECT HELPED 56,000 PEOPLE.

Winterization Project for Syria 2015-2016

Location: Aleppo and Idlib, Syria

October 2015 - June 2016

This project provided winter supplies to Syrians inside Syria.

ACHIEVEMENTS:

- Distributed tents, mattresses, plastic sheets and blankets

THIS PROJECT HELPED 53,804 PEOPLE.

Helping Conflict Affected Families in Syria Cope through the Winter

Location: Yalda, Babila, Beit Saham, Khan Esheih and parts of Dera'a, Syria

December 2015 - May 2016

This project provided newly displaced Palestinian refugees in Syria with mattresses to help them deal with the harsh winter weather.

ACHIEVEMENTS:

- Distributed 18,768 mattresses and 23 sanitary napkin packets

THIS PROJECT HELPED 18,768 PEOPLE.

Winter Campaign 2016 for the Northeast of Tunisia

Location: Tunisia | Jendouba, Beja, ElKef and Kassarine

December 2015 to January 2016

This project provided children in the northeast of Tunisia with winter clothes so that they could remain warm throughout the winter months while attending school.

ACHIEVEMENTS:

- 1,000 children in three governorates and 15 schools received winter kits. Kits included 1 coat, 1 woolen hat, 1 pair of gloves, 1 pair of socks, 1 neck scarf and 2 blankets.

THIS PROJECT HELPED 1,000 CHILDREN.
